


Purgatory

There is an easy solution to the problem of suffering in purgatory; there is an escape, there is an easy way out. The suffering soul can be released much earlier if someone pays up on his behalf.

Yes, God can be bribed with our money!!! According to Catholic doctrine he can be and he is just rubbing his hands as he is waiting for another donation.

If somebody on earth, someone who is still alive donates money to the R.C.C. on behalf of the suffering soul in purgatory then this miserable person can be released ahead of his time and be spared much of the suffering that was due to him.

It's a win-win for everyone! The suffering soul in purgatory wins as he gets set free ahead of his time, the person who donated the money wins because he has done such a good deed and the R.C.C. wins because it received the money it so desired.

The new 'purgatory marketing campaign' worked well and brought in large amounts on cash to the church.

As a result of it hundreds of millions of Roman Catholics have faithfully believed in this lie since the day it was born.

Only Satan could come up with such a crafty lie and thus deceive hundreds of millions throughout the century's right up to this day.




In Hinduism suffering is an essential part of life. Life consists of suffering and it is only through suffering that the human soul can finally escape this reality and reach Nirvana, be released from all earthly pain and suffering.

Catholics also had to also suffer much throughout the ages. Much of this suffering was inflicted on Catholics by their church itself.

Purgatory thus seems only a natural progression taking suffering to the next step of life.

But if purgatory is a reality, if this place really exists then the churches teaching may well be correct that we are cleansed of our sins by the hot flames of

purgatory. This means that Christ suffered and died completely in vein!



But this false doctrine, this lie of purgatory depicts God as the greatest failure of the universe!
For God had send His son to die on the cross for our salvation and he did so completely in vein!
All the suffering, all the pain which Jesus endured on the cross had achieved nothing at all.
God had inflicted all this suffering on his son for no reason at all!
How terribly cruel could such a father be to his son???

If we still need to be cleansed by the hot flames of purgatory then God is no father at all!
He would be the cruelest being which has ever existed.
He did not spare the life of his son when there was another way by which mankind could achieve their salvation.
If purgatory is real then the blood that was spilled on the cross was spilled for no reason at all.
It was wasted!

Purgatory is even a direct and outright contradiction to some of Catholicism's other doctrines.
But such happens when a church is thirsting after more money and power.
Compromises will soon turn into lies and those lies will eventually turn into contradictions and go against what the church had once taught in the past.
But because of Catholicism's authoritarian structure this doctrine of purgatory can no longer be removed, it can no longer be retracted. It has become a vital part of the catholic cannon and it must be taught and believed by anyone who calls himself a Roman Catholic today.

But the real tragedy of this deceitful lie goes much further than that.
The full extent of this evil lie will not even be realized here on this earth.
Here the 'faithful' are only cheated out of their money but the real tragedy will only occur once they have died.

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PURGATORY. The place or condition in which the souls of the just are purified after death and before they can enter heaven. They may be purified of the guilt of their venial sins, as in this life, by an act of contrition deriving from charity and performed with the help of grace. This sorrow does not, however, affect the punishment for sins, because in the next world there is no longer any possibility of merit. The souls are certainly purified by atoning for the temporal punishments due to sin by their willing acceptance of suffering imposed by God. The sufferings in purgatory are not the same for all, but proportioned to each person's degree of sinfulness. Moreover, these sufferings can be lessened in duration and intensity through the prayers and good works of the faithful on earth. Nor are the pains incompatible with great peace and joy, since the poor souls deeply love God and are sure they will reach heaven. As members of the Church Suffering, the souls in purgatory can intercede for the persons on earth, who are therefore encouraged to invoke their aid. Purgatory will not continue after the general judgment, but its duration for any particular soul continues until it is free from all guilt and punishment. Immediately on purification the soul is assumed into heaven. (Etym. Latin *purgatio*, cleansing, purifying.)
